

Lukas Kuhn (*o8.12.1996 in Germany) discovered his passion for the drums at a young age and received his first lessons at the age of five. After working with a private teacher and taking lessons at a music school, he began his "junior studies" with Professor Olaf Tzschoppe at the University of the Arts in Bremen in 2014. His Bachelor's degree followed at the same place in 2016, which he successfully completed in spring 2021. In addition to his classical activities in the orchestra or in contemporary music ensembles, he feels at home also in the popular genre with the drumset and his own band. Playing and experiencing very different music is an important concern for him and has a central role in his education.

From 2018 to 2023, he was a member of the "Junge Deutsche Philharmonie" and in the 2019/2020 season he completed his academy in the Philharmonic Orchestra of Bremen. He began his Master's degree in solo percussion, which is still ongoing, in October 2021 at the Berlin University of the Arts with Professor Simone Rubino.

In 2023 participated in the SONDER project "Pleiades under the Stars" performed in Bologna and collaborated in the development of SONDER's new interdisciplinary project "Das Lied eines Teleskops."
